How to get there:

PLEASE txt Mongo (0274 809 835) when your ferry actually departs, as often delays on Fullers. Details of your transport options can then be finalised.

Ferry Companies

Sealink - Car Ferry, but can do passengers only

From - Hamer St Auckland CBD at 8am

<u>Island Direct</u> - pre-book service (small boat)

From - Pier 13, Auckland Viaduct at 9.15am

<u>Fullers</u> - every half Hour (maybe - cues up around, 10am) during Weekend Peak Times. 9am is via Devonport, and 9.30am straight so aim for Run at 10.15am



The Plan:

Friday, 31st January or prior

Crash at 103 Trig Hill Rd (The Barn). BYO booze. Fish and Chips or a BBQ? (Probably decide on the day)

Saturday, 1st February

About 10am starting from The Barn, ramble down to Onetangi Rd (1km)- opposite the Golf Course - for a choice of 3 Breweries, a Distillery and 6 Vineyards. Let's call it the Ten Toes?

May end up walking to Onetangi (1km) for afternoon session at Charlie Farley's cnr Third Ave and The Strand.

Back at the Barn (1.5km - a bit of a climb - or Cabs?) then BBQ

Sunday, 2nd February

10.15am run from Matiatia - Coastal walk, plenty of time and piss stops. Some short cuts available.

\$20 each normally sees us through the day, for refreshments and lunch.

<u>If not staying</u> – plan for return to Auckland city from 3pm ish.

Walk up to Oneroa and catch any bus to Matiatia **OR** walk 2.5km to ferry from the beach.

If staying at The Barn – Evening activities and BBQ, or Curry from local? - TBC by the team of stayers

When you arrive on Waiheke:

Friday 31st January:

If at Matiatia before Friday Beer O'Clock, Taxi or Catch Bus (50A or 50B) to:

- Charlie Farley's, Onetangi (Stop#1102, Third Avenue); or
- Direct to "The Barn"
 - Bus- Onetangi Liquorland by Challenge Service Station (Stop#1106, Seaview Road) and walk up hill; or
 - o Taxi- 103 Trig Hill Rd "Waiheke Flowers", gravel Lower Drive turns into a sealed surface.
